I just want to start this update off by thanking you for supporting us so faithfully. These are not easy days in ministry when people don't want to be around you (lol, sort of). We seem to be in times of online ministry in so many ways. Our church did online only for a couple months, but are now back together, at least some of us. We really appreciate your prayers for us in these days as we look for opportunities to make disciples.

In our last couple of letters we communicated some difficulties that we thought might lead to resigning from our mission. With more communication with our headquarters, they have asked me to take on an area supervisory role which I have decided to pursue. I say pursue because our leadership is struggling to implement changes because of Covid-19. The beginning of these changes require people being together from various parts of the US. Please pray for wisdom in their planning.

In these days we are facing the circumstances of Covid-19, changes in our mission organization, and a decrease in our support levels. I don't often talk about money and our support, but we need to see our income go up or God to make changes for us to be able to keep going as we have. Maybe this means a change in our thinking and how we do ministry and life. We are not writing this asking you for more because every one of you have been supporting us for so long. We do ask that you pray for God's wisdom, direction and provision on our behalf.

I just recently got an opportunity to start a study online with a guy here in Tucson, along with two of his friends from college in different places in California. Two of them are very new to the bible and motivated to know God. This is going to be a long term study and will give them the message and big picture plan of the whole bible. Please pray that they would be motivated to stick with it from Genesis through the life of Christ.

Both Lisa and I have a few opportunities to meet individually with a few people to teach bible studies. Unfortunately that has decreased some in the last few months. For Lisa it is partially because she is going to be teaching at a Christian school starting this August. They are planning on doing this next year online with Zoom. There is a steep learning curve and a lot of different kinds of preparation. She greatly appreciates your prayer.
