Today, Christians in Poland are in great need. In a country of 38 million people, there are fewer than 600 evangelical churches, the majority of which tend decidedly charismatic, and there are very few trustworthy resources available to equip the church. This means that there is an ongoing susceptibility of Christians falling prey to the prosperity gospel, the word of faith movement and other forms of shallow, unhealthy theology.

With gratitude to God, we are pleased to announce the one-year anniversary of a website dedicated to supplying trustworthy biblical teaching in the Polish language that exalts the holiness and grace of God, equipping the church for Christian discipleship and gospel outreach.

For many years we had a desire not only to church plant, but also to build up the broader Polish church. In the fall of 2018, Rick Denham (international director of 9Marks) convincingly argued that the most effective way of influencing the church in Poland would be through a well-organized website. We soon after started working toward that goal and launched the website www.EwangeliaCentrum.pl by the end of February 2020.

We have published material from Charles Spurgeon, AW Pink, Mark Dever, DA Carson, John Piper, Paul Tripp, Kevin DeYoung, Stephen Nichols, David Mathis, Thomas Schreiner, and others, with every resource translated into the Polish language. Our two largest video curricula are *The God Who is There* by DA Carson and *9 Marks of a Healthy Church*. We are currently publishing weekly two podcasts, "Ask Pastor John" and "New Morning Mercies" by Paul Tripp. Desiring God, Crossway, and 9Marks ministries have partnered with us, helping us to publish nearly 100 articles in Polish. Many are stand-alone articles, but we have published two series of articles: *Good News of Great Joy*; 25 advent readings by John Piper and *Church Questions Series* by 9Marks.

In total we have published 215 different resources this year with new content coming out on average of four times a week - quite a pace for such a tiny staff. We now have well over 2,000 followers on Facebook and over 15,600 readers used the website in its first year.

What was accomplished this year would not have been possible without the hard-working team of people cooperating. We are incredibly grateful for the ministries that donated their English materials free of charge and in some cases actually paid to get them translated into Polish. We are thankful for a team of translators who volunteered their time and talents. Of course, none of it would have been possible without our generous supporters who financed this ministry. And finally, this accomplishment could not have happened without the irreplaceable Jan Stefanoff, an elder in the Siedlce church who has worked hundreds of hours on this website for a very modest salary.

We rejoice over the first year that God has granted and are excited about the possibilities as we move into year two. One of the biggest additions that we are working toward is adding Polish authors who are faithful Bible teachers to the American and British authors already on the website. An Expository Preaching curriculum from Proclamation Trust will also be added in the coming months.
