

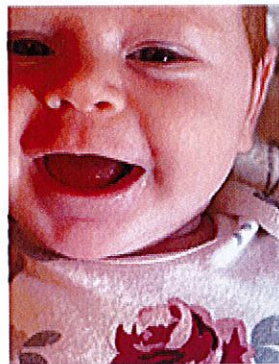
CHRISTMAS 2020
