WAIT in line, WAITING list We hear a lot about waiting every day. We have to wait in line if we need to pay a bill, if we need to buy groceries. We wait to see the dentist or doctor. We are waiting on a list to get a covid-19 vaccination. Our lives are controlled by lines and waiting.

There are some areas in which we do not have to stand in line to be served. Hebrews tells us to come boldly to God in prayer. No lines there. We are invited to believe in Jesus for salvation. By believing on what Jesus did for us on the cross there are no LINES to receive that gift. There are no lines in most churches to get into a service even with social distancing.

BUT if you have never heard the gospel and are members of about 2500 language groups then who knows when someone will come and tell you the story that is over 2000 years old. Who knows when someone will be willing to put in the time and training to learn the language and culture to give them the story of Jesus. THEY ARE ON A WAITING LIST THAT WILL AFFECT ETERNITY.
