I call these my "brick wall experiences" in life. You've no doubt experienced the same thing! Recently, I was made very aware that God used others to push, shove and drag me over some pretty crazy walls that I could not scale alone!!! Our four weeks in Arizona ended up being a totally unexpected major wall, unlike any we've ever experienced. After three ER visits and a week in the hospital, fighting infections, we returned home where both Paul and I are beginning to feel recuperated after some pretty extreme "wall climbing"! It's at times like these that we are so very aware of your prayers and love

"pushing and supporting" us up over these walls! Thank you for being our prayer warriors --- for your sweet notes of encouragement and concern. Thank you so very much for your financial support that is such a HUGE help to us! We appreciate you beyond words and we are SO blessed by you!

The WALL of recovery is not over yet but after just four months since my major spine reconstruction I can say "I'm fixed"! © I have felt this from the beginning! What a joy to be rid of the awful pain and to be able to now pull my shoulders back and look people in the eyes again! I AM still quite weak, and just today

finished a sixth round of antibiotics, so Lord willing, this is the end of it and I'll be able to regain strength. *Thank you for approaching this wall with us!*

Knocking down walls is kind of fun! Paul is mentoring a couple of the single guys here at the training center and he is enjoying getting to know these young men with such potential! He is able to do this more effectively as he has just gotten "new ears"!

His new hearing aides are "knocking down the walls" of deafness for him and we're excited to see the good results! Of course, the cost IS a huge wall for us, and we covet your prayers for this! He also just received the results of scans and blood tests for his chronic Lymphoma and heart issues and everything is NORMAL! No signs of growth of the lymph system so God continues to knock that wall down also!!!

There's a *Paraguay/Bolivia Wall* that is breaking our hearts! There continues to be BOXES of newly revised and printed Ayore Bibles sitting in Bolivia, unable to be shipped to Paraguay! They shut down the borders between the two countries months ago --- so there they sit! It thrills our hearts as we hear how the Ayore church continues to grow and mature! God is giving the young leaders a passion for their people and teaching them truth from the Word of God!

The thing about walls is that they are there for a purpose --- usually to protect or guard --- to set boundaries --- but who likes "boundaries", right?! ☺ (That is, unless you're the guys sitting on the inside of the walls of Jericho!) There is much to be said about "WALLS" and we are daily challenged to continue to step out, by faith in Almighty God --- who is the "Conqueror of Walls"!
