Our flight team was prepared and equipped to perform the various emergencies; thanks to the diligence of Larry and our home staff who had previously outfitted these aircraft to send them to PNG. It struck a chord, when a grandchild of a close co-worker had a ruptured appendix and was medevacked to Australia in one of the very same Kodiaks, saving his life. It is comforting to know that every link is vital to saving lives physically as well as spiritually for Christ. It is exciting to know that what we accomplish here at our headquarters is meaningful and touches lives for eternity! Thank you for being a vital part of this link!

The Lord answered countless prayers by providing NTM Aviation with 2 turbine R66 helicopters. One for the Philippine field and one for training purposes. Our NTM Aviation staff here at McNeal, AZ have been overwhelmed by God's provision in allowing us to have an engaging affect on our church planting missionaries around the world.

Thank you for being a team player by your involvement in our ministry through gifts and prayers. During this year, we have outfitted 3 Kodiaks and accomplished a 2200 hr overhaul on an R44 helicopter (which took 4 months of intense labor). Many repairs of cracked parts and new aluminum skins made. Built 2 Cessna 185 wings (1200 hours of work). What touches and renews our hearts inspite of the countless hours of physical labor? The reports of our pilots who fly in various countries regarding how the helicopters and aircraft on the fields are assisting in this unique task of reaching the unreached. Many of these people groups would be inaccessible if it were not for this method of transportation.
