

This weekend I traveled along the border visiting the elders from three churches and preaching at one on Sunday morning. The church service where I preached was packed full and that same thing is happening in most other evangelical churches in this area. Please pray that God will turn the hearts of Polish people to himself.

I would like to clarify a few important things about sending extra financial support during this time. One thing is clear, our expenses will increase significantly. Fuel was unavailable for about 10 days, now that it is available it has almost doubled in price. There is significant inflation across the board. We do have financial needs.

However, as I wrote in a previous email, we are focusing on four ministry goals during this crisis and only one of them is humanitarian aid. If you desire that your donation be spent in that way please pick a humanitarian aid organization and send them the donation.

The way that you could be the greatest help to our ministry during this time would be to send money as general support, allowing us to use it where we have the greatest needs and not feel pressure to use it in ways that are not necessary to the immediate need.
