We are in a very busy season of life and at times there are not many visible signs of progress. Quite often I've reminded myself of Paul's words to the Galatian churches, "Let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not."

It's time to renew our residency cards. Although we have lived in Poland for more than 20 years, we do not have permanent residency. We must reapply for temporary residency every 2 or 3 years. Of all the responsibilities of missionary life, I'm quite sure that I dread this one the most. It involves going to numerous government offices requesting and sometimes demanding the countless required documents. This time-consuming process takes a minimum of 6 months and is quite stressful. We've been working on it for a month already and have one of the most important meetings on the 19<sup>th</sup> of November. Please pray that I would find the time to get this huge task accomplished on top of our other responsibilities. Please pray those government workers would be favorably inclined toward our applications and that all four of us would quickly receive new residency cards.

This December marks 9 years of church planting work in Łuków. At the end of 2019 the tiny group had grown to a total of seven members. However, over the last year, two of those seven have been attending very rarely. Please pray for the handful of believers in Łuków - that God would sustain them in times of loneliness and discouragement. We have some evangelistic outreaches planned for November and December, so also pray that God would use these evangelistic outreaches to save souls and add them to this congregation.

One source of encouragement is related to the training of Polish pastors. Over the last 7 years, you, our supporters have paid for three young Polish men to attend Bible College in Scotland. Two of these three young men have returned to Poland and are in full time gospel ministry here. Of course, one of them works directly with us in Siedlce, Adam. The second young man serves in his church in western Poland. I recently had the opportunity to spend a few hours with him and I rejoiced to know that a few thousand dollar investment from our supporting churches has helped set this young man on a path of preaching and teaching in Poland, that Lord willing, will endure for decades and touch hundreds, if not thousands of lives.
