He has been faithful in taking his light frequency therapies....taking cancer pills and seeing Drs. and getting more tests...

Until lately , Paul has had no pain but a tightness in the neck which is normal for as big as the cancer has grown!! He doesn't sleep well, still has acute pain in his unoperated shoulder. Then the growth I believe has been laying on something in his right arm which always feels like he had slept on it and couldn't feel it normally. SO... WE COVET YOUR PRAYERS!

Paul is able to do a lot of things praise God! Not like before. but still he keeps going! Of course he loves the prison nites of the week where he can go and share God's love. Saturday usually has 5-9 guys that come. They are there for sexual sins! So far Paul has met two Pastors in that group :(May we all walk circumspectly in this wicked world!

Just recently Paul was able to baptize 5 men that are in the largest group he has on Sunday nite. He was appalled as they undressed and had only the essentials on for the baptismal...Tattoos everywhere!!! hardly a spot unpainted on their bodies ! But...I just know that these marks will not go to heaven with these dear men!!When I saw a young man with so many on his person,I'd ask..."Did you ask your Mother first?" No! That was every answer I received!

Other Inmates...one for instance was not able to see his wife for three years! What with Covid and its restrictions the rules were many! When they were lifted he got to visit with her and hold her hand, tho he got reprimanded by the guard!! Oh my! Prison isn't a happy place for sure, but I know that my Husband is bringing in the best joy they can experience! One Sunday nite, one of the prisoners came up to Paul and greeted him. Paul knew he was familiar but couldn't remember who he was... "Im Javier, Paul!" Oh

yes Paul thought but again, because of restrictions, they couldn't hug, but with a warm hand shake they were reunited!! Sad that Javier was back in prison, but we were grateful he sought Paul out and attended his meeting once again! Upon Javiers request, Paul just got word from the head Chaplain, that he will be able to baptize Javier and 2 others!!...I am missing out on all of this but am hoping that sometime soon, if God wills. I will join him! Until then. I am Paul Dye's Prayer Warrior at home like you!!
