


Hello from Tucson Arizona. We want to again express our thankfulness for your participation with us in this ministry. Without your support, prayer and fellowship with us we could not be dedicated full-time to what God has called us to. Thank you so much for your faithfulness.

We continue teaching our online ministry preparation course in Spanish and have just finished our third year. During the summer months, we have been able to concentrate on other areas of ministry. We have been preparing for teaching that starts again in September and spending time with other ministry leaders of like mind. We have also developed our website in Spanish which is now online. Our English program with the rest of our team continues and will be starting their fifth year this September.



We are very encouraged with how we are able to help people in their knowledge of God's Word and with working with others in the body of Christ. We have a group of people in Nogales Mexico receiving our training, the pastor of this group has no formal training himself. He is very encouraged with his own growth and with being able to take some of his people through this course. It is people like this that help motivate us to keep going with the same kinds of things day after day and seeing God do something new day after day.

Since moving to Tucson Arizona last year, we really feel like we are settling into life here. We have settled into an English-speaking church and continue working toward helping this church reach out to the Hispanic community. Our home and our church are located in a community with at least an 80% Latino population. The potential for making disciples is incredible, but helping a primarily Anglo church make that transition in a significant way is a serious challenge and requires a lot of patience. Please be praying with us that God would open doors and give us the courage to implement the necessary changes to make disciples in this bi-cultural / bi-lingual environment.
