It seems like a repeat of last year as Larry continues the process of painting another helicopter involving the trainees in learning this technique.

The goal is to have the 2nd helicopter for PNG in a 40 foot container, ready to ship by the 1st of March, and then begin painting another new R66 helicopter for its service in Southeast Asia. He and the other mechanics will outfit it with marine grade plywood floors, D-rings for cargo tie downs, V2 tracking for flight following, wooden decks that replace the bottom seats to haul heavy cargo (making use of extra space that the leather seats occupy), HF radio, tuner, power inverters, HF antenna with bracket mounts, fabricating doublers, DART float installation, weight & balance and track & balance of the main rotor and tail rotor. It is thrilling to know that these aircraft will be used to help reach some of the millions of unreached people groups with the WORD of TRUTH.

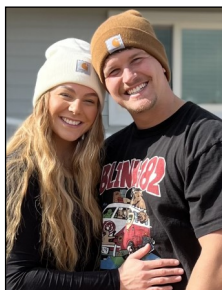
